## Jazy J Training Rules

1. DRIVE SLOW ON THE PROPERTY!!!
2. Only Current Club Members are allowed to train on the Property
3. Club members cannot bring guests with dogs.
4. The compound area around the house is off limits.
5. No training on the house pond is allowed until after 12 noon on weekends.
6. When training at the house pond be courteous and stay to the eastside away from the house as much as possible.
7. When training at the house pond do not shoot towards the house.
8. When training at the house pond do not park vehicles up near the yard.
9. Pick up your trash and any other trash you see.
10. Do not leave dead birds on the property.
11. Large groups for training must notify Joe/Dottie and get permission (4 or more handlers /6 dogs).
12. Be courteous of others and don't hog the water.
13. Be sure to shut any gates that were shut when you went thru and leave any gates open that were open.
14. When the prairie is wet stay to the dikes and road.

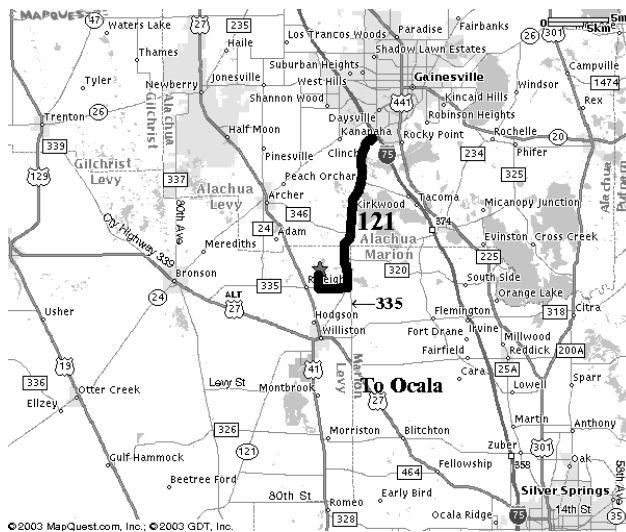
